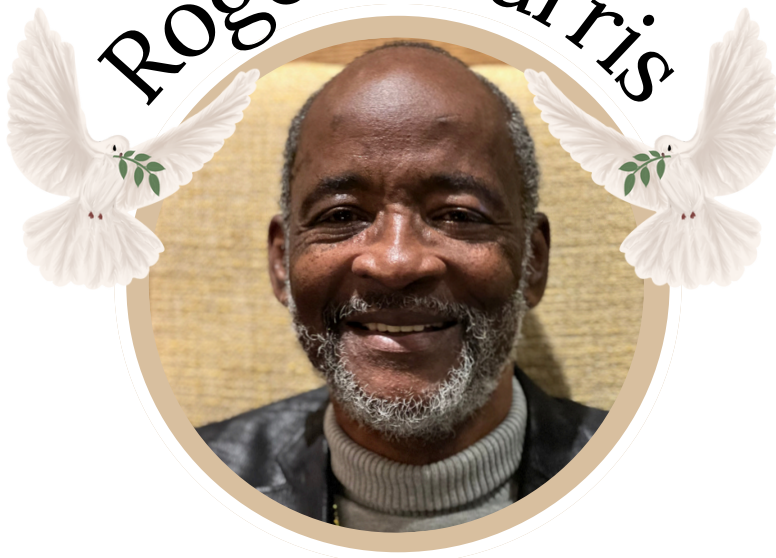

# Obituary

Rogers Leon Cleveland Harris, born on October 8, 1950, in Goochland, Virginia, peacefully transitioned on August 1, 2024, in Atlanta, Georgia. He was the devoted husband of the late Lucy R. Harris and the son of the late Dorothy Gabbin Mealy and Cleveland Willie Harris. Rogers was also preceded in death by his sister, Agatha Mealy. He is survived by his son, Dominique Robinson Sr. (Kametrise), and three cherished grandchildren: Dominique Jr., Ariaiah, and Noemi. He is also remembered with love by his sister, Laverne Crawford (Pete); his four sisters-in-law, Julia Glenn, Nettie Williams, Linda Douglas (Joe), and Rosa Lee; his brother-in-law, Clarence Robinson; one nephew Calvin Crawford Sr., one great nephew Calvin Crawford Jr., two great nieces Briana and Brittany Crawford, and a host of relatives and friends who hold him dearly in their hearts. 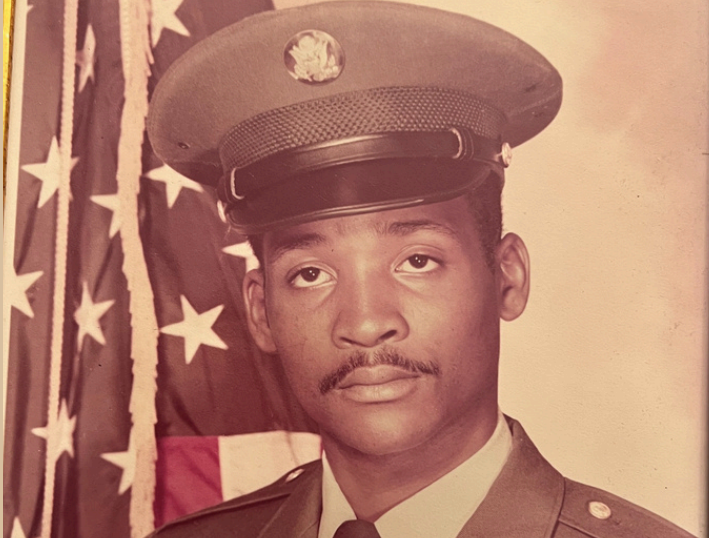

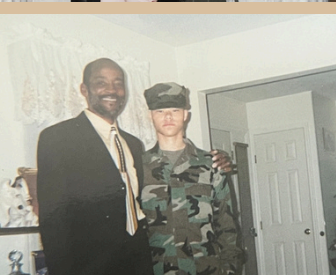
